DAY ONE – 15th April 2017

Ring 1

- Class 1 - Encouragement Class** – This class is open to novice combinations, any age, any height. Any suitable bridle. Lead rein allowed. Walk and trot only – no cantering. To be run as a ridden showing class with each competitor receiving feedback from the judge. Rosettes to all. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A.
- Class 2 - Ridden Skewbald/Piebald** – Rider any age. Lead rein allowed 1st & 2nd qualify for championship A/B/C
- Class 3 - Ridden Riding Horse/Hack/Hunter** – Exceeding 14.2hh, rider any age. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship B.
- Class 4 – Ridden Walk & Trot** – Lead rein allowed. Rider any age. No cantering Any bridle. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A.
- Class 5 - Tiny Tots Lead Rein** – Ponies 12.2hh and under, riders 8 years and under. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A
- Class 6 - Ridden Veterans** – Open to horses and ponies aged 15 years and over, rider any age, lead rein allowed. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A/B/C
- Class 7 - Ridden Junior Mountain & Moorland (Pure and Part Bred must be Reg'd)** Rider 16 years and under. Lead rein and first ridden allowed. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A/B/C
- Class 8 – In Hand Pure Bred** – Open to horses and ponies. Must be registered with any breed society as a pure bred. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship D
- Class 9 - Ridden Unregistered** – Open to horses and ponies, Lead Rein Allowed. Not to be registered with any breed society. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A/B/C.

- 5.15pm E3 – Fancy Dress/Onesie Class** – Open to all. Fancy dress or Onesies allowed (rider or pony – or both!!!). Ridden or Inhand. £5.00 Entry fee Non members – Free to members
- 5:45pm - Team-Tasstic Award** - A number of finalist rosettes for this class will be awarded throughout the day to competitors and their support team (family, friends) who are showing team spirit throughout the show. Teams to come into arena unmounted.

- Class 10 - Ridden Thoroughbreds/Arabs Pure & Part** – Any height, rider any age. Lead rein allowed. Must be registered. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A/B/C.
- Class 11 - In Hand Large Mountain and Moorland (Pure and Part Bred must be reg'd)** – 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship D
- Class 12 - In Hand Small Mountain and Moorland (Pure and Part Bred must be reg'd)** – 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship D
- Class 13 - In Hand Part Bred** – Open to horses and ponies. Must be registered with any breed society as a part bred. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship D
- Class 14 – In Hand Rescue Horse/Pony** - Open to horses and ponies. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship D
- Class 15- Ridden Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony & Hunter** – 14.2hh and under, rider any age, lead rein allowed. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A/C.
- Class 16- Ridden Rare/Foreign Breeds (inc Warmbloods) Must be Reg'd** – Open to horses and ponies, rider any age. Lead Rein Allowed. Rare breeds to include Cleveland Bays, Suffolk Punch, Hackney, Exmoor, Dales, Fells Clydesdale, Dartmoor, Shire, and Highlands. Foreign Breeds: Any breed not originating from Britain/Ireland. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A/B/C
- Class 17 - In Hand Alternative Colours** – Open to Spotted, Duns, Roans, Creams, Palominos. Any height. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship D
- Class 18 - In Hand Veterans** – Open to horses and ponies aged 15 years and over. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship D
- Class 19 – Ridden Small Mountain and Moorland (Pure and Part Bred must be Reg'd)**
Rider any age, lead rein allowed. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship A/C

DAY ONE Ring 3

- Class 20 - Adult Handler** – Handler 14 years and over. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship F.
- Class 21 – In Hand Miniatures/Shetlands** – Open to Miniature Horses and both Standard and Mini Shetlands. 1st and 2nd qualify for Championship D
- Class 22 - In Hand Best Turned Out** – Open to horses and ponies. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship F.
- Class 23 - In Hand Unregistered** – Open to horses and ponies. Not to be registered with any breed society. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship D
- Class 24 - In Hand Driving Type.** Any age, any height. May be shown in harness (no carriages though please!). 1st and 2nd qualify for championship D
- Class 25 - In Hand Thoroughbreds/Arabs (Pure and Part Bred must be reg'd)** – 1st and 2nd qualify for championship D
- Class 26 - In Hand Skewbald/Piebald.** Horse or pony. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship D
- Class 27 - In Hand or ridden Best Condition Horse/Pony** – 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship F
- Class 28- Pony the Judge Would Like to Take Home - Ridden or In Hand** – 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship F
- Class 29 -- In Hand Sports Horse and Pony** – 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship D

Class 31 - 1'3" - 1'6" Working Hunter Open to horses and ponies. Riders any age. Lead rein allowed.

1st & 2nd qualify for Championship G.

Class 32 - 1'9" – 2' Working Hunter Open to horses and ponies. Riders any age. 1st & 2nd qualify for Championship G

12.30 – 1.00 – **Clear Round Working Hunter fences 2'0- 2'3"** £6 per round. Pay on the gate.

Rosettes to all clears.

Class 33 – 2'0" – 2'3" Working Hunter Open to horses and ponies. Riders any age.

1st & 2nd qualify for Championship G

Class 34 - 2'6" Working Hunter Open to horses and ponies. Riders any age. 1st & 2nd qualify for Championship G

Class 35 - 2'9" – 3' Working Hunter Open to horses and ponies. Riders any age. 1st & 2nd qualify for Championship G

DAY TWO 16th April 2017 – Ring One

Class 36- Ridden Part Bred – Open to horses and ponies. Lead Rein Allowed. Must be registered with any breed society as a part bred. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship H/I/J.

Class 37- Ridden Rescue Horse/Pony – Open to horses and ponies. Lead Rein Allowed. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship H/I/J.

Class 38 - Ridden Plaited Horse/Pony – Rider exceeding 16 years. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship I/J

Class 39 - Ridden Novice Horse & Pony – Rider any age, lead rein allowed. Horse or pony not to have won 3 firsts in ridden showing classes. 1st and 2nd into championship. Riders may choose whether to compete in the beginner championship (H) or their relevant height championship (I/J) –

Class 40 - Ridden Bays, Blacks, Greys, Chestnuts – Open to horses and ponies, rider any age, lead rein allowed. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship H/I/J.

Class 41 – Ridden Large Mountain & Moorland (Pure and Part Bred must be Reg'd) Rider any age. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship I/J.

Class 42 - First Ridden – Ponies 12.2hh and under, riders 12 years and under. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship H.

Class 43 - Ridden Cob Hogged– Open to horses and ponies to be shown hogged & trimmed, rider any age. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship I/J.

Class 44 - Ridden Junior Un-plaited – Rider 16 years and under. Lead rein and first ridden allowed. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship H/I/J

Class 45 - Ridden Pure Bred – Open to horses and ponies. Lead Rein Allowed. Must be registered with any breed society as a pure bred. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship H/I/J

Class 46 - Ridden Cob Hairy to be shown untrimmed– Open to horses and ponies , rider any age. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship I/J.

5.00pm Class E4 - Inhand Concours D'Elegance - Evening or costume dress to be worn to be judged on the overall picture. Rosettes to all entries. Restricted to 15 entries.

5.15pm Class E5- Junior Concours D' Elegance Evening or costume dress to be worn side saddle or astride to be judged on the overall picture. Riders under 16 years old. Rosettes to all entries. Restricted to 15 entries.

To be judged by an independent judge. Champion to go forward to the supreme.

DAY TWO - RING Two

- Class 47 - In Hand Youngstock** – Any type, 1-3 year olds. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship K **Ridden**.
- Class 48 - In Hand Riding Horse/Hack/Hunter** – Exceeding 14.2hh. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship K.
- Class 49 - Best Turned Out** – Open to horses and ponies, lead rein allowed. 1st and 2nd placed qualifies for championship M
- Class 50 - Lead Rein** – Ponies 12.2hh and under, riders 10 years and under. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship H.
- Class 51 - First Year First Ridden** – Riders in their first year off the lead rein. Ponies 12.2hh and under, riders 12 years and under. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship H
- Class 52 - Ridden Newbie** – Open to horses and ponies, rider any age. Lead rein allowed. Rider not to have competed at a championship show in a ridden class before 1st January 2017 (if a rider has previously competed on the leadrein, they may enter this class off leadrein providing they have not previously competed at a championship show off leadrein). No cantering. 1st and 2nd place into Championship - Riders may choose whether to compete in the beginner championship (H) or their relevant height championship (I/J)
- Class 53- Ridden 4,5,6 Year Old Horse & Pony** – Rider any age. Lead rein allowed. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship H/I/J.
- Class 54 – Ridden Alternative Colours** – Open to Spotted, Duns, Roans, Creams, Palominos. Any height . Rider any age. Lead rein allowed. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship H/I/J.
- Class 55- Ridden Junior Plaited** – Rider 16 years and under. Lead Rein and First Ridden Allowed. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship H/I/J
- Class 56 - Senior Rider** – Riders 40 years and over. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship I/J
- Class 57 - Ridden Un-Plaited Horse/Pony** – Rider exceeding 16 years. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship I/J
- Class 58– In Hand Novice Horse/Pony** – Horse/Pony not to have won 3 firsts in hand. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship K

RING Three

- Class 59 - In Hand Newbie** – Open to horses and ponies. Handler not to have competed at a championship show in an in hand class before 1st January 2016. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship K
- Class 60 - In Hand Rare/Foreign Breeds (inc Warmbloods) Must be Reg'd** – Open to horses and ponies. Rare breeds to include Cleveland Bays, Suffolk Punch, Hackney, Exmoor,Dales, Fells Clydesdale, Dartmoor, Shire, and Highlands. Foreign Breeds: Any breed not originating from Britain/Ireland. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship K
- Class 61 - In Hand Cobs** – Open to horses and ponies. To be shown hairy. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship K
- Class 62 - In Hand Cobs** – Open to horses and ponies. To be shown hogged 1st and 2nd qualify for championship K
- Class 63 - Prettiest Eyes - Ridden or In Hand** - Open to horses and ponies. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship M.
- Class 64 - Handsomest Gelding - Ridden or In Hand** – Open to horses and ponies. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship M.
- Class 65 - Prettiest Mare - Ridden or In Hand** – Open to horses and ponies. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship M.

Class 66 - In Hand Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony & Hunter – 14.2hh and under. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship K

Class 67 - Junior Handler – Handler 13 years and under. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship M.

Class 68 - Thelwell – In hand or ridden. 1st and 2nd qualifies for championship M.

RING Four

8.30 – 9.00 – **Clear Round Working Hunter – Fences 1'0-1'3"** £6 per round. Rosettes to all clears. Pay on the gate.

Class 69 – Leadrein and Beginner Working Hunter – Fences maximum 1'3". Open to horses and ponies . 1st and 2nd qualify for Championship N.

Class70 – Novice Working Hunter Horse and Pony – Fences: 1'6" – Ponies, 1'9" – Horses. Ponies to jump first. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship N.

9.00 – 9.30 – **Clear Round Working Hunter – Fences 1'9"** £6 per round. Rosettes to all clears. Pay on the gate

Class 71 - Mixed M & M Working Hunter. Smalls to jump first fences 1'9". Large fences 2'0". 1st & 2nd qualify for Championship N

Class 72 - Ridden Riding Club Horse, exceeding 14.2hh, rider any age, any bridle. Will include a small jump 1st & 2nd qualify for Championship I

Class 73 - Ridden Pony Club Pony 14.2hh and under, rider any age, will include a small jump, any bridle, no spurs 1st & 2nd qualify for Championship J

Class 74- Intermediate Working Hunter Horse and Pony Fences: Ponies 2'0", Horses 2'3" – Ponies to jump first. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship N.

Class 75 – Working Hunter Grand Prix Open to horses and ponies. Ponies to jump first. Fences 2'6" ponies, 3'0" horses. 1st and 2nd qualify for championship N
